CLEAR CHOICE CLINIC MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT EXPANDS TO HUNGRY HORSE

KALISPELL, MT—Clear Choice Clinic has expanded its Mobile Medical Unit (MMU) to include service in Hungry Horse, in addition to its existing service in Browning and Eureka, Montana. The MMU provides women and men medical and educational services, including free and affordable STD testing and pregnancy diagnosis, nursing consultations, and education on the options available during a pregnancy.

The clinic was established in 2007 to offer free, confidential pregnancy testing and limited obstetrical ultrasound to women experiencing an unplanned pregnancy. Last year, the mobile unit extended the clinic's services beyond the Flathead Valley, to Lincoln and Glacier Counties.

Upcoming Mobile Medical Unit visits, scheduled the second and fourth weeks of each month, include:

- **Eureka**, TUESDAY, October 13 and 27, and November 10 and 24
- **Browning**, WEDNESDAY, October 14 and 28, and November 11 and 25
- **Hungry Horse**, THURSDAY, October 15 and 29, and November 12 and 26

According to Executive Director Michelle Reimer, the MMU helps new and future parents in underserved areas of Montana receive top-notch care and education. "We provide options education and consultations on all choices available to parents," she said, adding that "Clear Choice Clinic and the MMU offer a professional medical team in a compassionate and respectful environment."

Clear Choice Clinic, a non-profit organization, is supported by the Gianforte Family Foundation, The New Life Survivor's Trust, The Frederick and Margaret L. Weyerhaeuser Foundation, and numerous private donors.

Staffed by a team of professional nurses, a sonographer and two medical directors, the clinic is accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care. All medical services are provided under the direction and supervision of Medical Directors Ken Graham, MD, a pediatrician with Sunny View Pediatrics in Kalispell, and John Lavin, MD, a partner at Kalispell OB/GYN.

To support parents beyond the initial pregnancy diagnosis, Clear Choice Clinic partners with Hope Family Resource Center, at 940 1st Avenue East in Kalispell. Hours are Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The resource center offers a well-stocked Baby Boutique and an Earn While You Learn program that provides parents a curriculum designed to provide education about pregnancy and parenting for moms and dads.
